

# 2020 QUALIFYING CONTRACTOR COMPLIANCE

## REQUIREMENTS

All items below must be included with application in order to become a Pre-Approved Contractor.

### CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCES FROM INSURANCE COMPANY:

1.  \$500,000 (minimum) Each Occurrence/\$2,000,000 (minimum) General Aggregate Commercial General Liability Insurance.
2.  Company Vehicles Liability Insurance.
3.  Workers Compensation: Maine Statutory Limits, contractor has employees.  
or
4.  Workers Compensation Certificate of Independent Status, contractor has no employees.  
(Contractor has been approved by Worker's Compensation Board to not carry Workers Compensation Insurance.)

### CERTIFICATES For contractors who may disturb Lead Painted Surfaces.

1.  EPA's Renovation, Repair & Painting (formally: Lead Smart Renovator).  
(All owners *and* workers must have a current certificate on file.)

### EPA FIRM CERTIFICATION For contractors who may disturb Lead Painted Surfaces.

1.  Contractor has provided an EPA Lead-Safe Certified Firm Certificate.

### WORK HISTORY For all contractors.

1.  Contractor has provided 3 home repair related work projects with references on Contractor Application.

### LICENSES:

1.  Electrical.
