## YOU SHOULD APPLY TO MAINE'S NEW RENTAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Maine has \$200 million in rent relief funds from the federal Emergency Rental Assistance Program. This program will provide rental and utility relief payments to help eligible renters maintain housing stability. Aroostook County Action Program will review applications, check eligibility, and process payments for eligible expenses on behalf of Aroostook County households.
